



The Manufacturers Education Foundation Scholarship

The Manufacturers Education Foundation, in partnership with American Made Movie and American Town LLC, is providing scholarships to promote careers in manufacturing.

Selection: The Technical College System of Georgia Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee shall select and shall notify the scholarship recipient. The Donor will be notified after the selection process is completed regarding the name of the recipient.

Award: Scholarships amounts are based on the Track selected. Funds are to be used for tuition, books, program supplies, and other educational expenses. Before funds will be disbursed, the Technical College System of Georgia Foundation Office must receive a note of thanks from the recipient to the donor(s) to be mailed by the Foundation Office.

Termination: If the recipient fails to enroll, withdraws from the college, or does not maintain eligibility requirements, the Technical College System of Georgia Foundation will select another student if time permits; otherwise, funds will be held in the Donor's account to be carried over to the next semester, if the student continues to pursue an education in manufacturing.

High School Pathway: Track A

Scholarships will total \$1,000 each, and disbursed \$500 per semester

Eligibility Requirements: In order to qualify for a scholarship provided from The Manufacturers Education Foundation, a student must:

- A. Be a citizen of the United States and a resident of the state of Georgia;
- B. Expected or recent (prior school year) graduate of a Georgia high school and/or participated in programs with one of Georgia's career academies or high school CTAE manufacturing programs;
- C. Accepted into one of the Technical Colleges and preparing to enter one of the following program areas or area that transitions the applicant to the field of manufacturing: Automated Manufacturing Technology, Engineering Technology, Electronics Technology, Industrial Systems Technology, Industrial Maintenance, Electrical Maintenance, and Mechatronics or others related to manufacturing;
- D. Enrolled in a minimum of one manufacturing class per semester and on track to complete program in the expected time frame;
- E. Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5;
- F. Currently employed in manufacturing, or a desire to enter the field of manufacturing once applicant has graduated;
- G. Demonstrate financial need (Tax Return, FAFSA Application, or other document that can substantiate income) and;
- H. Demonstrate in a letter (500 words or less) how this scholarship will benefit the applicant and his/her future educational plans.

Application cannot be processed unless all required documentation is attached to application at the time of submittal.



The Manufacturers Education Foundation Scholarship

College Pathway: Track B

Scholarships will total \$2,000 each, and dispersed \$1,000 per semester.

Eligibility Requirements: In order to qualify for Track B, a student must:

- A. Be a citizen of the United States and a resident of the state of Georgia;
- B. Be enrolled in one of the Technical Colleges in one of the following program areas that prepare the student for a career in the field of manufacturing: Automated Manufacturing Technology, Engineering Technology, Electronics Technology, Industrial Systems Technology, Industrial Maintenance, Electrical Maintenance, and Mechatronics or others related to manufacturing;
- C. Have a GPA of 2.5 and have earned at least 15 hours in desired program area;
- D. Be currently employed in manufacturing or express a desire to enter the field of manufacturing once the student has graduated;
- E. Demonstrate financial need (Tax Return, FAFSA Application, or other document that can substantiate income) and;
- F. Demonstrate in a letter (500 words or less) how this scholarship will benefit the applicant and his/her future educational plans.

Application cannot be processed unless all required documentation is attached to application at the time of submission.

Fall Semester Award: Postmarked by June 30

Spring Semester Award: October 31
